Salmon Bay Eagles F.O.E. 2141 has been supporting the blues in Ballard now for 34 years and we are so thrilled to celebrate with our members and the public so get the word out! It's a great night of music and fun!

The John Stephan Band play a blend of original and traditional blues, R&B, and roots music and has the perfect set-list for a live show tailor-made for dancers. Since 2000, they have become a popular, established PNW group with two critically acclaimed albums. The group performs at clubs, festivals, and parties throughout the region, featuring top-flight players, and a tight, unique sound. John has performed in the Seattle area since 1974. Originally from Palmer, Alaska, John has played roots music since childhood, and played rock and soul music in the Anchorage area in the 1960's. He's worked with the who's who of Seattle blues artists including Isaac Scott, Little Bill, Mike Lynch, Paul Green and Mark DuFresne to mention a few. The band hits the stage at 8pm.

SALMON BAY EAGLES: A HISTORY OF BLUES

It all started out back in December of 1989 when the late Jimie Jean Tuttle along with then Worthy President, Dave Duff, went to Kevin Wallace to put together a house band for a Sunday evening blues jam which consisted of Jimie Jean's husband, the late Kirk "Spiderman" Tuttle on drums, Jeff Davies on bass, Fast Freddie, Kevin on guitars and Raven Humphres, among others, sitting in whenever they could make it. This then moved to Thursday nights and evolved from a hosted jam into actual bands playing. Marcia Jackson (aka The Kitchen Wench) has also strongly supported these weekly blues nights for much of the run with her wonderful homestyle cooking. Our very own Past Worthy President, Mike Haldeman, also deserves recognition for keeping the blues alive at the club. as well as many others including Dennis "Zab" Zyvoloski, Terry Curtis and Malcolm Kennedy who've helped book and promote great local blues talent. To this day, the blues rolls on at the Salmon Bay Eagles, and is recognized as one of the premier local blues venues.

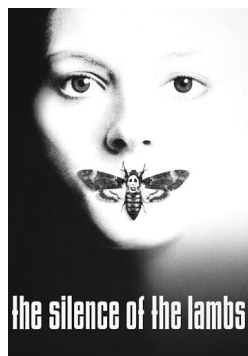

ON THE COVER: ERNESTINE ANDERSON

Ernestine Anderson (1928-2016) was an internationally renowned American jazz and blues singer. Her connection to Seattle began when her family moved to the city 1944, and she was discovered by bandleader "Bumps" Blackwell, who hired her as a singer for his Junior Band. Anderson's first show was at the Washington Social Club on East Madison Street. The band (which later included fellow Garfield High School grad Quincy Jones on trumpet, and a young Ray Charles on keyboard) performed regularly in jazz clubs on Jackson Street. In a career spanning more than six decades, Anderson recorded over 30 albums, living and touring all over the world before returning to Seattle in 1973.

Polly O'Keary & the Rhythm Method, Saturday, January 13

Polly O'Keary and the Rhythm Method is the trio she built with her husband and drummer, Tommy Cook. Pulling in influences from zydeco, country, funk, jazz, rockabilly, surf and rock and roll, they bring a searing and joyful performance of today's blues to audiences across the U.S. and Canada. The band has released four critically acclaimed albums, has had a #1 single on contemporary blues radio and a #4 album charted on Living Blues, received a total of 26 awards from the Washington Blues Society and the Inland Empire Blues Society, including Best Songwriter, Best Blues Guitar, Best Blues Drummer, Best Blues Vocalist, and Best Blues Bass, among others.

Helen Burn & Co, Saturday, January 20

Helen Burn grew up playing the piano and then studied with Ken Olendorf after moving to Seattle. She caught the music bug through open mic nights. Now, the main quartet includes Pavel Shepp on drums, Randy Cole on bass, Alexis Mauer on guitar and Helen Burn on keys and vocals. They play originals and a few covers, including jazz standards and pop. Why Burn & Co and not Burn Band? Don't be surprised if a guest artist joins. It's gonna be a great time as the band keeps the up tempo going all night long!

Tim Turner Band, Thursday, January 25

Singer, songwriter, guitar player extraordinaire, Tim Turner has been plying his craft in the Seattle area for four decades. Give Tim an electric guitar and a stage and the outcome is always first-rate guitar playing, great singing and outstanding original tunes. Tim has been playing his unique and special brand of blues, rock and rhythm n blues since the 1970's. Whenever he's on stage, he has the uncanny ability to bring out the best in whatever musicians are on stage with him and takes audiences on a musical joy ride.
